Holy Trinity Academy Graduation Policy



Rationale:

The administration recognizes and supports our grade 12 students in preparing for their graduation. We outline the following priorities for our grade 12 students throughout their grade 12 year.

- 1. All students meet the academic requirements needed for a high school diploma in Alberta by May 15 of the graduating year. By May 15, a student must be achieving at least 50% in a required course for graduation or the students will not be able to attend graduation ceremonies.
- 2. All grade 12 students from Holy Trinity are required to attend a graduating class retreat in the spring.
- 3. A student must achieve a 50% or better in Religious Studies 35 by May 15 in order to attend the commencement exercises. This includes 20 hours of volunteer service.
- 4. Students must be in consultation with the High School counselor in order to determine registration and completion of specific courses they may need in order for post-secondary entrance.
- 5. The organization and preparation of graduation events such as the dinner, dance, and commencement exercises following the celebration of the Eucharist as a school and parish community will be conducted by the staff and students of Holy Trinity Academy.

The guidelines are as follows:

COMMITTEES

There will be a general meeting for all grade 12 students during the second week in February. An overview of the Holy Trinity Policy regarding graduation will be explained at this meeting.

- 1. A graduation committee will consist of Grade 12 students and the Administration.
- 2. There will be three (3) sub-committees under the umbrella of the Graduation Committee.

These committees will be called the: a. Liturgical Committee

- b. Banquet Committee
- c. Decorating Committee
- * Please note that all after-grad activities must be conducted outside of Holy Trinity premises.
